As your son/daughter has recently moved into P7 you have undoubtedly started to think about their next step onto secondary school. I would like to introduce myself as the Depute Rector responsible for the P7 Transition at Beath High School, and to share a few helpful details if you are considering sending your son/daughter here.

Normally around this time I would warmly welcome you to our early P7 Open Evening. Unfortunately, due to current Covid-19 restrictions this will not be possible. Instead of this, your son/daughter's school will also send a link to a Sway which contains the information I would normally share during this event.

The back of this letter includes the full transition programme so that you have an idea of what your son/daughter can expect over the next year. As I am sure you can imagine due to the current global situation this may be subject to last minute amendments out-with our control, and I will communicate any changes if required.

This year Fife Council are using a new electronic enrolment system for all young people moving from P7 to S1. This is a simple electronic form and full details will be shared once it is open. The closing date for all enrolments via this system is 15<sup>th</sup> March 2022 and any placing requests will be informed of the outcome in April 2022.
