



Over the past few months, in line with our school meal review action plan, the Food & Nutrition Team have been visiting schools to deliver sessions on the Eatwell Guide and how some of our tasty school meal recipes can be recreated at home.

Caitlyn visited Ballumbie Primary School in Dundee for their Fit Friday, and Nicole visited Invergowrie Primary School in Perth and Kinross. They spoke to pupils in P1–4 about the


importance of a balanced diet and how different foods fit into the Eatwell Guide. The pupils enjoyed the end-of-session game Caitlyn and Nicole had prepared, and they also shared their feedback on the current school menu along with suggestions for future menus.

The Food & Nutrition Team were also invited to work once again with NHS Tayside as part of their Best Foot Forward programme. So far, Norrie, Carly, and Caitlyn have attended sessions at Sidlaw View Primary in Dundee and Warddykes Primary in Angus, where Norrie demonstrated how to make our Tomato and Korma sauces at home using different protein options.

The team look forward to continuing their collaboration with NHS Tayside on the Best Foot Forward sessions, with another visit planned in Perth and Kinross in the new year



Why not try making our Sweet Potato & Butternut Squash Soup at home?



Serves 4, Preparation time: 5 mins, Cook time: 30-35 mins

Ingredients:

- Sweet Potato 100g
- Butternut Squash 100g
- Diced Carrots 75g
- Diced Onions 75g
- Vegetable Bouillon 10g

- Boiling Water 400ml
- Cumin 1g
- Mild Chilli Powder 0.5g

Method:

- 1. Prepare the sweet potato and butternut squash
- 2. Add all ingredients to a pot and bring to the boil
- 3. Simmer until the vegetables are tender
- 4. Blend the soup. Be careful if doing this while hot!
- 5. Enjoy!


Leon's Star Tip:

An easy way to peel butternut squash and sweet potatoes is to cut them into round discs on a chopping board, and use a knife pointing downwards to peel.

School Meals Plate Waste - Phase 2



Some of you may remember from our newsletter earlier this year that a Food Waste Pilot Project was carried out by Tayside Contracts, in partnership with primary schools in Tayside at the start of 2025. The aim was to reduce school meal plate waste across Tayside and increase environmental awareness among primary school pupils to positively influence their behaviours later in life.

The pilot which is aligned to our school meal review actions followed a three-stage approach:

Stage 1 – No pupil engagement

Catering staff weighed and recorded plate waste.

Stage 2 – Pupil engagement, which included:

- Posters displayed around the school and in dining areas
- Age-appropriate videos explaining the environmental impact of food waste
- 'Waste Warriors' in high-vis vests helping to weigh and record plate waste

Stage 3 – No intervention

Catering staff again weighed and recorded plate waste to compare results.

We are pleased to say we are now working on launching phase 2 of this project with more schools across Tayside starting January 2026.

So far we have had an engagement session with the volunteer schools and we are about to issue welcome packs to each school in preparation for the project commencing at the beginning of next term.

A big thank you in advance to all the participating schools and catering teams!





You will need:

Toilet paper roll or a paper towel roll

Scissors

Paint

Paint brush

Scruffy paint brush or old toothbrush for splattering

Thread for hanging

Time needed: 30 minutes

1. Paint Toilet Roll Tube

Paint your cardboard rolls in whatever colours you'd like, blending two or more colours to get a more interesting effect. Swish your paintbrush around the inside of the roll to paint the inside as well.

2. Splatter paint

To give your icicles a frosted effect, dip a scruffy brush or a toothbrush into some white paint and gently splatter it over the painted toilet roll tube.

3. Cut roll lengthwise

Cut the cardboard roll lengthwise into a spiral, following the seam that runs around the roll. Now cut this piece lengthwise into two spirals.

4. Roll and stretch your spiral

Roll each of these spirals up nice and tight. You might want to roll it around a pencil or the handle of a paintbrush. Remove the pencil or paintbrush and gently stretch your spiral out to form your icicle.

5. Attach hanging thread

Attach a loop of thread by dabbing a bit of hot glue at the top of the icicle. Alternatively, you could poke a small hole in the top of the icicle to poke your hanging thread through.
