Dear Parent / Carer

It has been a really positive start to the year!

The new term has been the usual whirl of activity with busy, happy children settling into new routines. Children are looking very smart in new school uniforms - thank you for making an effort with this. Our high expectations of uniform standards will continue throughout the year.

Our Primary 7 children have been helping our P1s with settling in. They are taking their responsibilities very seriously and rising to the challenge!

Below are some of the annual reminders of how we do things in Robert Smillie as well as school calendar dates that you will need across the year.

School Routines

Please make sure your child knows who will be picking them up at the end of the day. Lunch time is from 12.15pm to 1pm. If your child is going home, please make sure they know the arrangements for this.

PE, Shoes

PE times are on the school app. On a PE day, children should wear a polo shirt. This helps children to get ready quickly for their PE slot!

Cheap black gym-shoes are perfect for PE and indoor use.

Clothing

We already have some lovely new items of un-named clothing in school lost property. Please can parents label ALL clothing! We will write names on labels if we can match an un-named item with a child!

Drinks through the day

All children are encouraged to take water with their lunch. You may also provide your child with juice for lunch if you prefer.

In class we ask that children drink water (not juice). Milk is also available (ordered on parentpay) to drink. This is given to children just after their morning interval.

Health, Safety and Hygiene Routines:

As per last year, we will establish positive routines with the children around hand washing, and general hygiene, especially at key points of the day. Windows in classes will be open throughout the year to ensure that classrooms are fully ventilated to help reduce viral transmission.

The school heating system will be on earlier in the year and will be boosted to keep classrooms warm. However, there may be occasions where classes are slightly cooler than normal. If your child is cold, please give them an extra layer of clothing that can be worn in the first instance.

Attendance

Good attendance is essential to children doing well at school, both socially and academically. Once again, we are looking for better school attendance this year. If your child is ill, you must let us know first thing by leaving a phone message stating your child's name, class and absence reason.
