Halloween Discos

The Halloween discos have proved very popular with the children over the years, and we look forward to welcoming the children to them on the evening of Thursday 26 October.

Children in P1-P3 should attend from 6.30-7.30 and P4-P7 from 7.45-9.00.

Children should enter via the gym hall doors. Parents / carers should pick up the children from the hall at the end of their disco. For safety reasons, we will not allow the children to walk home



alone, so please make sure your child knows the arrangement for being collected after their disco. Tickets for the disco will be on sale in school from Monday 23 October, priced at £2.00.

We are also operating a costume swap for Halloween. Please hand in any previously used costumes that are in good condition. Families are invited to take any of these for use by their own children. It should save families money and is a great method of recycling.

On Halloween itself, (Tuesday 31 October), children can wear their Halloween costumes to school, if they so wish. There will be activities in the classroom, and we will have our usual parade in the gym hall, where the children get a chance to see everyone else's costume.

Please don't make the costumes too scary as it can be upsetting for the younger ones. Also, there should be no weapons as part of the costume for either the discos or the Halloween parade. If anyone turns up with a weapon as part of their costume, they will be asked to hand it in and will be able to collect it at the end of the disco or the day of the Halloween parade.
