














### **THIS WEEK'S** LEARNING NEWS

### What we got up to!

P6 – Primary 6 had a successful week this week. The boys and girls started their new numeracy topic, money. We looked at using the four operations to solve money calculations. They also looked at budgeting and worked out different ways to save money. P6 also continued reading chapters of our class novel Wonder. We completed comprehension questions and were introduced to some new characters in the story. P6 also successfully delivered their solo talks Infront of the class. Everyone had an excellent, detailed and well researched PowerPoint to support their talk and received positive feedback from their peers. Lots of hard work and resilience shown from P6 – Well done!

P7 – Primary 7 also had a successful week with their writing and numeracy tasks, also focusing on their novel study and starting their new numeracy topic, money. In numeracy the children focused on debit cards and credit cards, and we learned about APR and how to calculate interest. P7 also completed their last 2 sessions of bike ability lessons with Mr. Matthews, learning all about the safety of cycling on the road and in public places. They showed respect and good listening skills throughout. P7 also presented their solo talks to the class with well detailed power point presentations to support them during their talk. They were all excellent!
