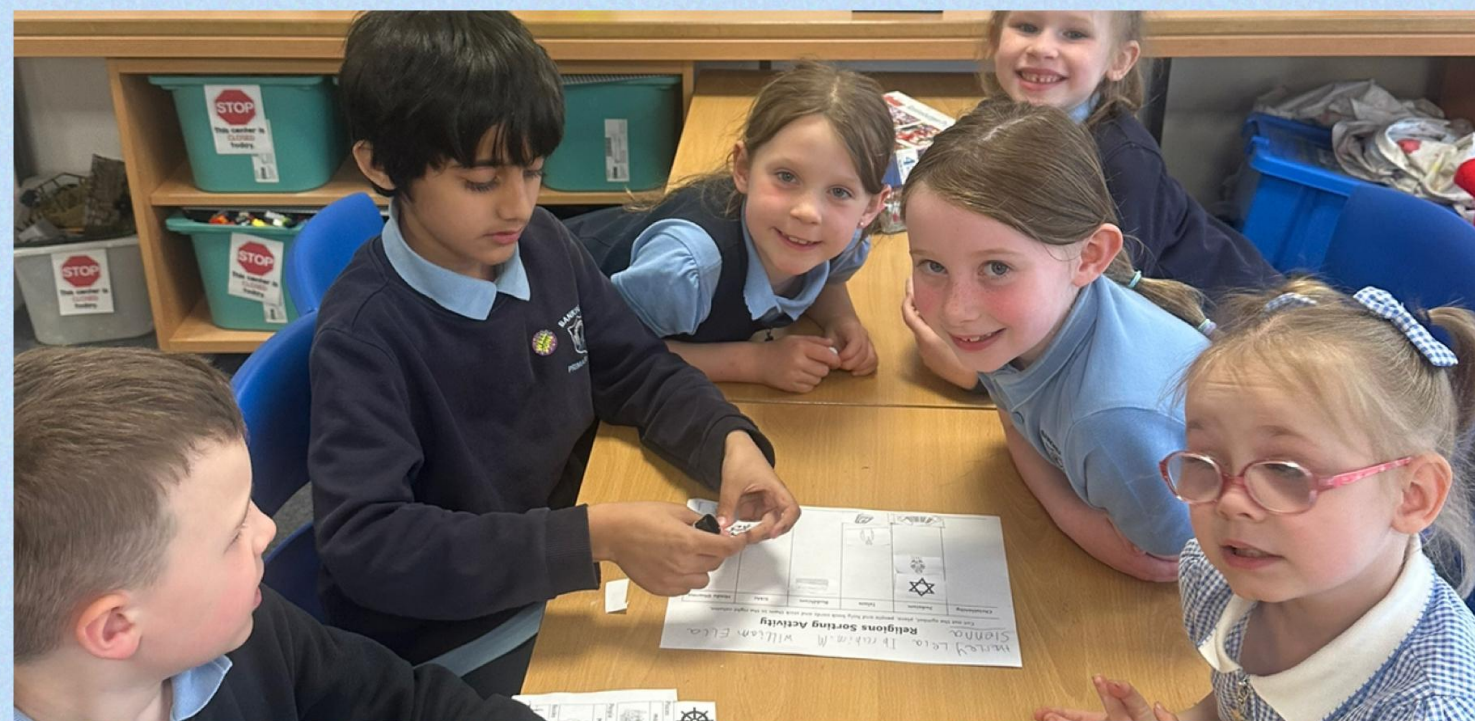

Wednesday 25th June—School closes at 1pm for summer holidays.

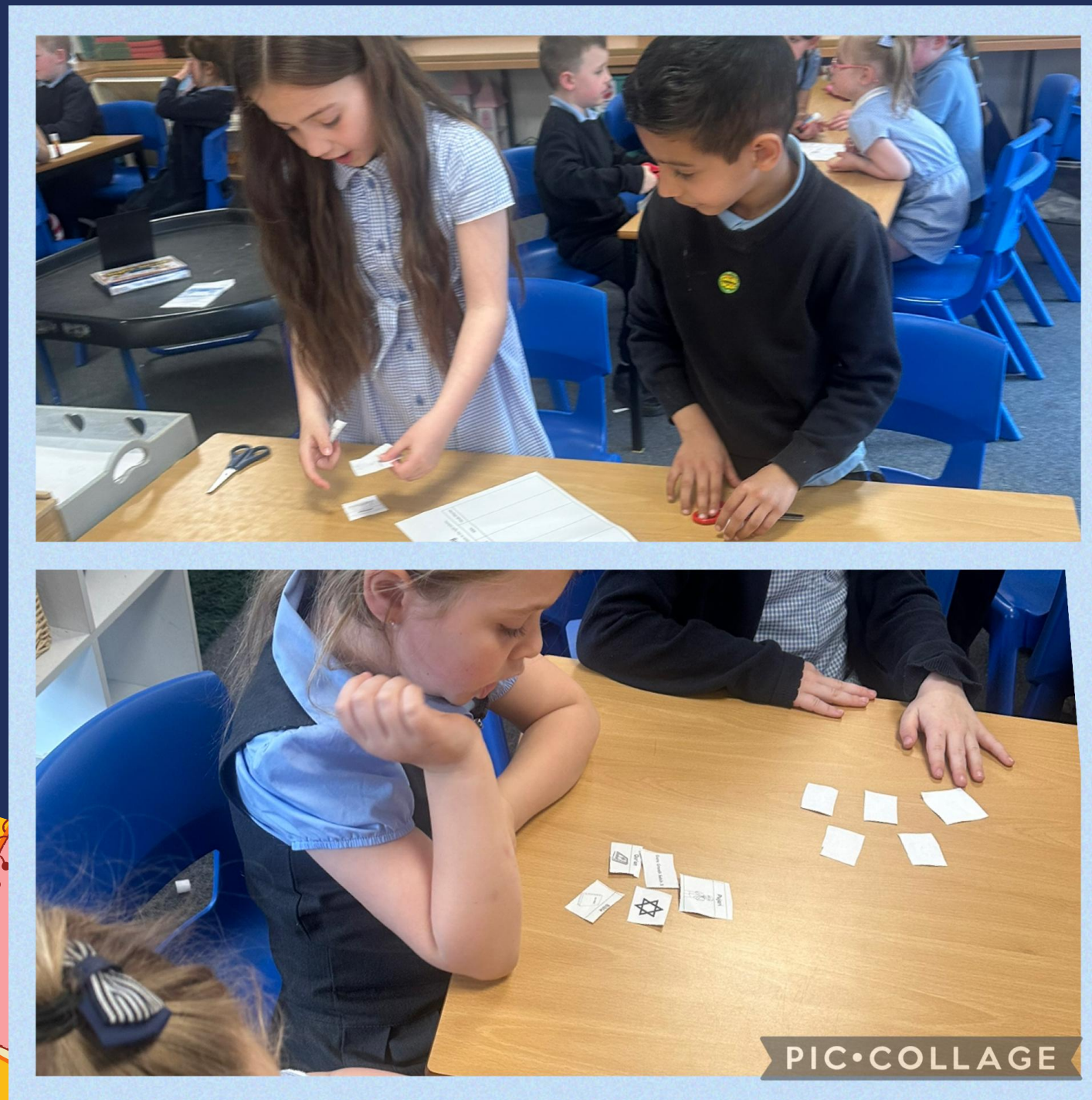
