

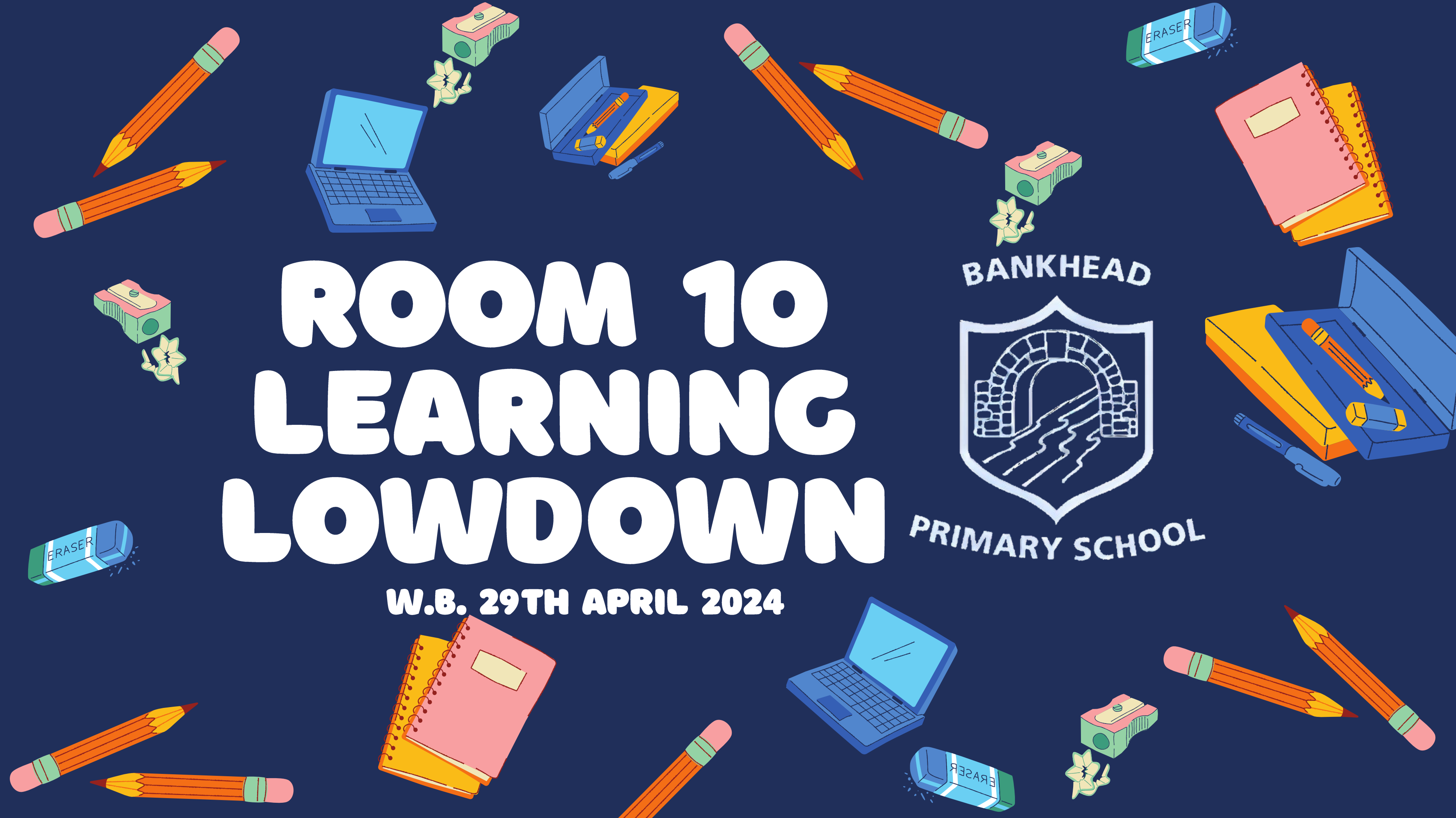

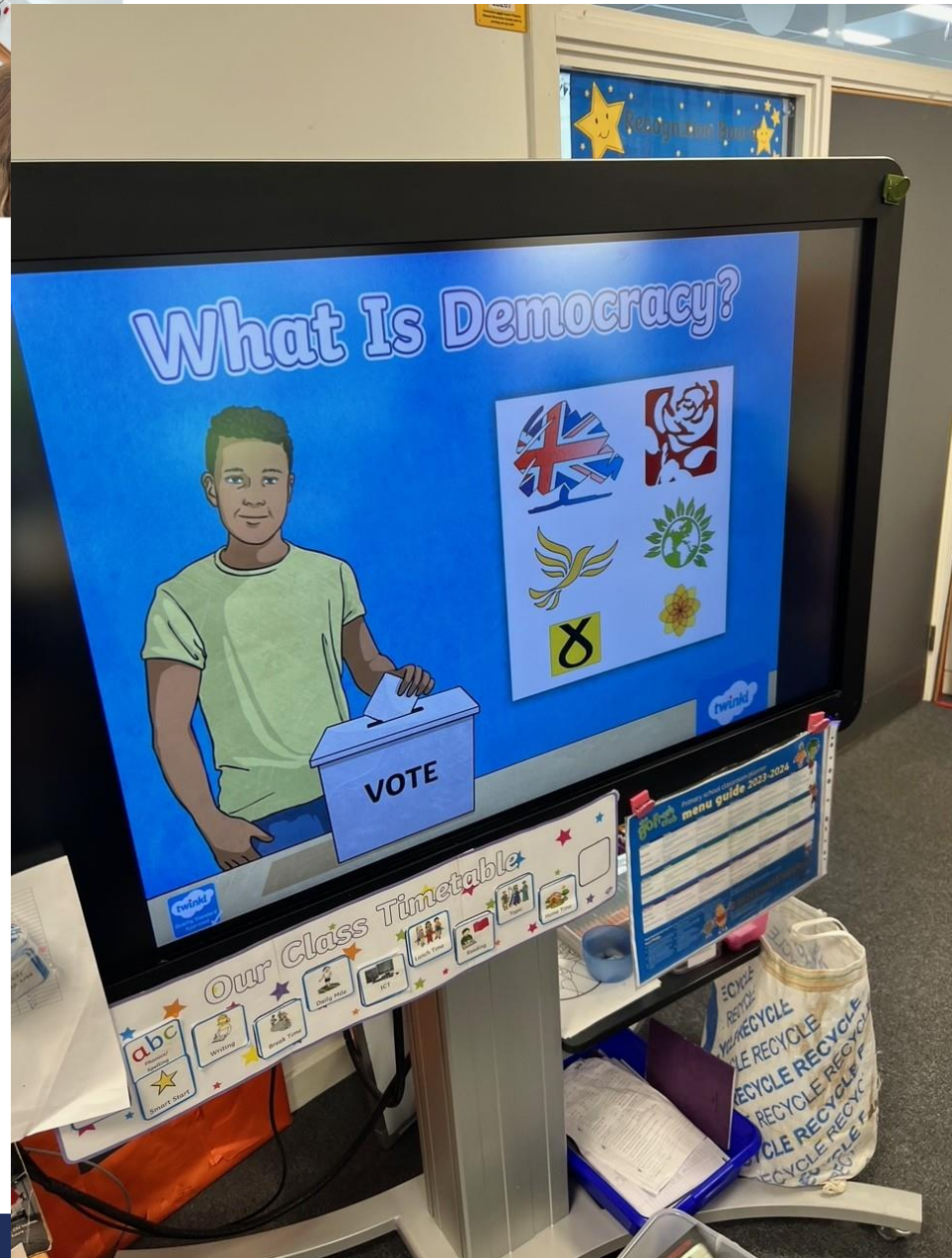
# THIS WEEK'S LEARNING NEWS
