### Maths

- Divide numbers using 9 and 10.
- Practise your times tables (11 and 12.)
- Measure items around the house or garden using mm, cm and m.
- Explore and identify right, acute, straight and obtuse angles of items around the house.
- Create directions using a sequence of instructions. (NSEW, full turns, half turns, quarter and clockwise/anticlockwise)

### Literacy
