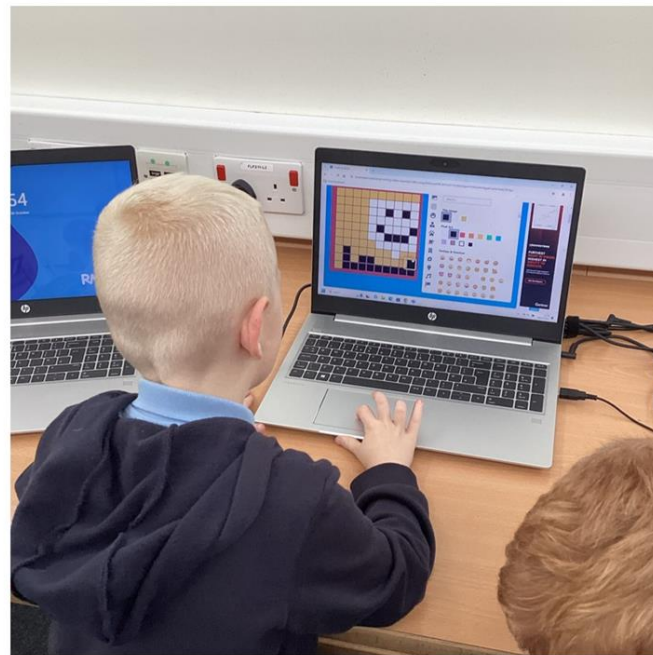
THIS WEEK'S LEARNING NEWS

This week in Room 5...

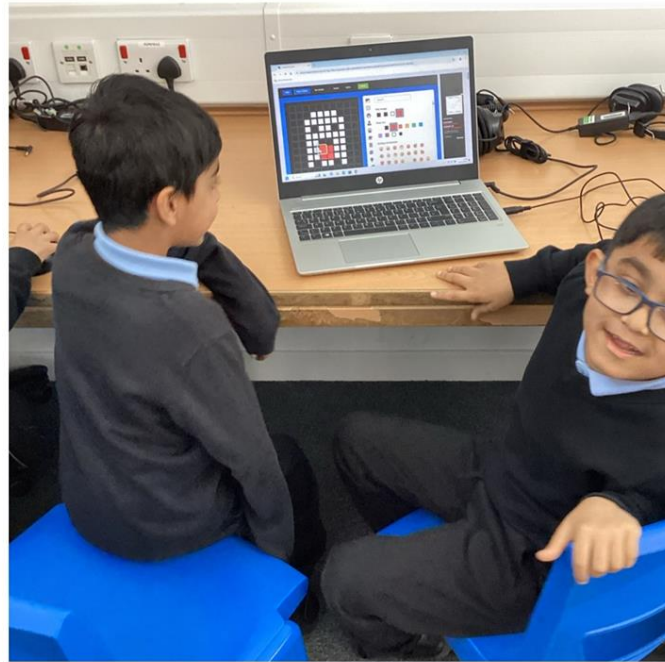
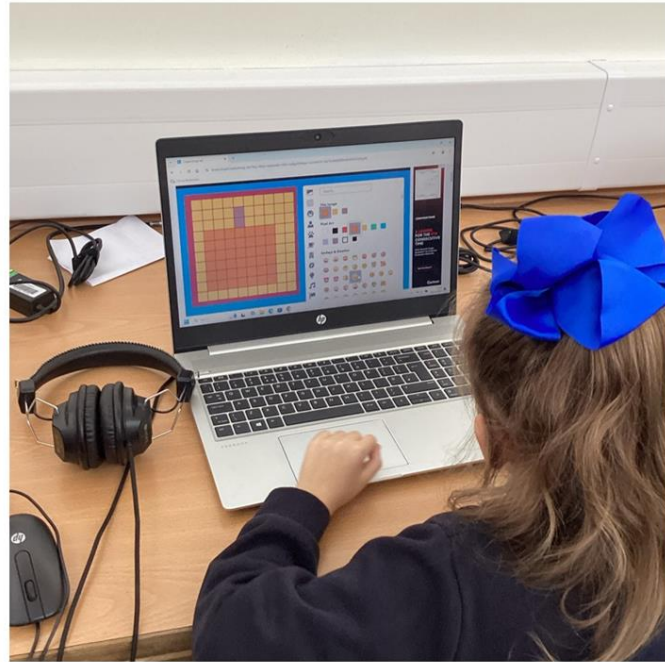
