Literacy

In Literacy, we have been continuing our novel study Holes by Louis Sachar. The children are thoroughly enjoying it and the variety of literacy, technology and art tasks that go with it. They have been enjoying using Digital Literacy as a stimulus for their creative writing, particularly when writing their recount of the spooky <code>Dracula</code>'s Whitby. Numeracy
