The boys and girls in Room 4 have settled in so well to the new routines of Primary 2 and 3. We have been working very hard, learning new things and having fun along the way! Miss Hepburn and Mrs McFall are super impressed with the hard work taking place in Room 4.

Literacy

In Literacy, we have been learning to read, recognise, write and spell words using our phonemes. We like thinking of strategies that could help us spell our common words. We have also been working on our writing skills. We wrote spooky Halloween acrostic poems that Miss Hepburn was very impressed with and now we are learning to write letters.

Numeracy

In Numeracy, we have been looking at different strategies for solving addition sums. We know all of our number bonds to 20 and we have been using number lines, 100 squares and concrete materials to find the strategy that works best for us. We are now looking at written methods and then we will begin to explore how these strategies could help us with subtraction. In Maths, we have been learning to identify the features of 2D and 3D shapes.

Other Curricular Area

Our topic this term is Our Local Area: Bothwell. We have learned about different places in our community and how they help people, how we can take care of our community and we looked at historical pictures to see how Bothwell has changed. We have been very excited about this topic and have enjoyed exploring our local area – we have even taught Miss Hepburn some new things about the area.
