Literacy

We will continue to build on this. We have started our home reading books too. These books are introduced to the children the week before.



Numeracy and Maths

In Numeracy this term, we have been working on our numbers to 10. We have been counting, giving quantities and focusing on formation. We will continue to extend our number knowledge beyond 10.

In Maths, we have already explored sorting, pattern and shape. We will be moving on to learning about data handling and symmetry.



Learning across the curriculum

To start off Primary 1 we shared information about ourselves and learned about forming new friendships. We also explored the Zones of Regulation, learning about the different colours and ways to help us stay in the green zones.

Our topic this term is People Who Help Us. We have already had a look at the Police and the Fire and Rescue service.
