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Literacy

Sounds we will focus on in term 4 are ll, ff, ss, zz, qu, ng and magic e.. Details of the tricky words and spelling words will be sent out on TEAMS first thing on a Monday morning.

This term we will focus on sentence openers, alphabetical order, using a dictionary and plurals (adding s and es). Please continue to revise ORT words and tricky words regularly.

We will continue to read 3 times weekly in class (I book per week) and send home a book weekly to read for enjoyment.

P.E - every Tuesday with Mrs Marrs. Term 4 will focus on athletics and sports practice.

ICT— Every Thursday with Mr Schoolar.

Over the course of term 4 we will be learning about time covering o clock and half past in both analogue and digital as well as time durations. We will also be covering the topics of area and the beginning stages of multiplication as well as 3D shape.
