Reminders

Primary 1 - Term 4



Literacy

This term we will be revising all Jolly Phonics sounds with a focus on vowel digraphs - ai, ee, ie, oa, ue, ou and oi. We will continue to spell three and four letter words and tricky words. In writing, we will be writing simple sentences within dictation, weekly news and within the context of Dina's Adventures. We will practise writing our sounds. We will be reading in class two/three times a week and some children may bring a book home to share with parents/guardians. The children will continue to be issued with word boxes in order to develop their blending skills. The children will continue to be introduced to "Tricky Words" and ORT words which will help with their reading and writing. We will be reading lots of stories and we will encourage the children to retell their own stories.

Numeracy

We follow the Samson Maths programme of study which involves learning about number, money, addition and subtraction. At the Early Level, the children also learn about 2D/3D shape, pattern, direction, symmetry, time, measure and data handling. This term, we will be counting orally to fifty and beyond. We will focus on numbers from 0-30 and ensure that the children can recognise, count, order and write 0-30 and understand the value and position of each number. They will consolidate their understanding of mathematical language - less than/more than, one/two more/less than, largest/smallest and numbers before, after and between. The children will continue to develop their understanding of addition and subtraction within ten. They will learn to recognise coins up to $\pounds 2$ and use coins to pay the exact value for items up to 10p. The children will also learn about time, symmetry, halves and 3D shape.

Curriculum

In PI, we learn through play which helps us to reinforce our learning within all curricular areas whilst developing independence, creativity, communication, problem solving skills, resilience and respect for others.

We will continually reinforce our classroom rules and routines and we will continue to encourage the children to establish and develop friendships.

Our topics for this term will be Spring and Summer. All children will receive input from Mrs Carter for Music and Miss Quince will continue to support and improve the children's athletic and small ball skills in PE.

<u>Homework</u>

Homework tasks will be sent home in homework folders **and** they will be posted on our PI TEAMS page. Please check on a daily basis for new tasks, sign homework records and click 'like' on TEAMS to show when they have been completed. Comments are welcome too if your child has completed this well or if they have had any difficulties. Take time to practise all sounds, word boxes, tricky words, ORT words, reading, number formation and addition/ subtraction stories. Please take some time to share stories and play games with your child at home.

Also, children are welcome to bring in topic related items from home to explore at our Investigation Station.
