Reminders

Literacy

This term Group I will be learning the sounds s, a t, i, p n, c ,k ck, e, h, r, m and d.

Group I children will be learning to blend words using all known sounds. They will also learn to write the sounds. Group 2 will be learning the sounds ck, ai, ay, oa and ow as well as revising Tricky Words from last year. Details of the spelling words and tricky words will be sent out on TEAMS. In writing they will focus on using capital letters and full stops. They will also be learning all about adjectives and how to use adjectives within our writing. Please continue to re-vise ORT words and word boxes as well as tricky words.

Numeracy

We follow the Samson Maths programme of study which involves learning about number, money, addition and subtraction. All the children also learn about 2D/3D shape, pattern, direction, symmetry, time, measure and data handling.

This term, group I will be counting orally to ten and beyond. The children will learn to form the numbers 0-9. We will also focus on mathematical language - less than/more than, one/two more, largest/ smallest and numbers before and after.

They will also look at patterns and 2D shapes.

Group 2 will be focusing on addition to 20 We will also be covering the topics of 2D shape, patterns and symmetry. Please check TEAMS for details of maths homework which is sent home regularly.

Please also practise the following too. Number ordering, ordinal number (first, second, etc) number between and recognition of number names.

Curriculum

In PI and P2, we learn through play which helps us to reinforce our learning within all curricular areas whilst developing independence, creativity, communication, problem solving skills, resilience and respect for others.

We will continually reinforce our classroom rules and routines and we will continue to encourage the children to establish and develop friendships.

Our topic for this term will be 'Me and My Family.'

All children will receive input from Mrs Carruthers for music and in P.E. we will be working on improving the children's bilateral skills and large ball skills.

Homework

Homework tasks will be sent home in homework folders and they will be posted on our PI/2 TEAMS page. Please check on a daily basis for new tasks, sign homework records and click 'like' on TEAMS to show when they have been completed. Comments are welcome too if your child has completed this well or if they have had any difficulties.

Take time to practise all sounds, word boxes, tricky words and number formation. Please take some time to share stories and play games with your child at home.

Also, children are welcome to bring in items from home to explore at our Investigation Station.
