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Literacy

Reading—This term we will be reading *The Hobbit* as a class, focussing on introducing more complex story telling and vocabulary. We will be using *Book Detectives* to look at further texts as groups and pupils are also encouraged to read for personal enjoyment.

Writing—This term we will focus on writing comparison pieces and using appositives. We will be aiming to create balanced arguments using more complex, persuasive

Maths

Core maths

This term we are focussing on Place Value, Addition and Subtraction. This will set the pupils up for success with the topics we will cover later in the year.

Mental maths

We are focussing on mental addition through the SAMSON method this term where we will build upon what the learnt in Primary 5 and introduce trickier questions.

Curricular Areas

PE—This term we will focus on large ball skills including basketball and rugby.

Health and Wellbeing—We will focus on what makes a good friend and understanding and managing emotions.

Languages—This term we will focus on German, including classroom language and body parts.

RME—This year we will focus on Christianity and Judaism. Term One will include stories from the Bible, St Andrew and Rosh Hashanah

Our topic for this term is Europe and we will be focussing on the European Union, countries of Europe and the Berlin Wall. We will be using atlas skills as well as ICT skills through research projects such as creating a database and planning a holiday.
