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Literacy

Sounds we will focus on in term 3 are oa, ow, o-e, ie, i-e, igh, y, ue and ew. We will also be looking at common words (previously known as tricky words). Details of the weekly sound and spelling words will be sent home on a Monday, please practise these with your child to help consolidate their knowledge and understanding.

Writing - This term we will continue to structure sentences carefully remembering to use capital letters and full stops. We will try to link two ideas in a sentence using a conjunction and we will think about different ways to


Curricular Areas

In RME we will learn about epiphany, the story of Noah's Ark, Moses, St Valentine and Jesus and his miracles. We will learn all about the Easter story.

In French we will extend counting to 31. We will recap colours and learn the words for various classroom and household items. We will learn the names of the days of the week and the months of the year in French. All children will receive input from Mrs Carter for music, and in P.E. we will be focusing on floor gymnastics and fitness.

Maths

With Mrs Fergusson we will be focusing on numbers to 100, where we will be looking at ordering numbers, looking at the numbers before and after, 10 more than/less than and sequencing numbers. SAMSON - this term we are focusing on our mental recall of addition facts to 10. Please practise number ordering, ordinal number (first, second, etc), number after/before and between numbers to 100.



With Mrs Vivers we are working on data handling, making and understanding graphs and charts, We will also measure liquids in volume and calculate area by counting squares.

Topic

Our topic for term 2 is 'weather'. This will involve learning about types of weather and the seasons. Children are encouraged to bring in objects from home relevant to our topic for discussion.
