Literacy

Sounds we will focus on in term 3 are **ch**, **th**, **wh**, **ee/ea**, **oo**, **ai/ay**, **oi/oy and oa/ow**. Details of the tricky words will be sent out on TEAMS.

This term we will continue to focus on adjectives and using these in our writing. We will also be learning a wider range of conjunctions (e.g then, so, because) and pronouns, common nouns and proper nouns.

Please continue to revise ORT words and wordboxes as well as tricky words (if your child still takes these home).
