# Primary 6A - Term 2



## Literacy

<u>Reading</u>—This term we will continue reading The Hobbit as a class, focussing on introducing more complex story telling and vocabulary. We will be using Book Detectives to look at further texts as groups and pupils are also encouraged to read for personal enjoyment.

<u>Writing</u>—This term we will focus on writing nonchronological reports and using higher quality punctuation and conjunctions.

## <u>Curricular Areas</u>

 $\underline{PE}-This$  term we will focus on floor gymnastics and social dance.

<u>Health and Wellbeing</u>—We will focus on hygiene related to preparing food and various forms of keeping healthy.

Languages—This term we will focus on French, including months of the year, colours, the family and conversational French.

<u>RME</u>—This year we will focus on Christianity and Judaism. Term Two will include charities, The Torah, Hanukah and Christmas.

# <u>Maths</u>

#### <u>Core maths</u>

This term we are focussing on Multiplication, Division and 2D Shape. We will introduce long multiplication and pupils should continue to practise their times tables regularly.

#### <u>Mental maths</u>

We are focussing on mental subtraction through the SAMSON method this term where we will build upon what was learnt in Primary 5 and introduce trickier questions.
