Literacy

We will continue to read 'Friend or Foe' which helps us understand about evacuee life.

Writing in this term will teach pupils how to write procedural, explanation, response, exposition and report extracts.

The class will have comprehension sessions twice a week where they will learn a variety of reading comprehension techniques.

This term we will introduce more talking and listening sessions where skills for how to more successfully communicate will be developed.

All children should aim for their best presented work at all times. Pupils will receive a new spelling list each week. Practise will be in school but we encourage pupils to work on these at home too. Some children will continue to use NESSY to support their learning in spelling.

Maths

We will continue to revise all previously learnt topics from throughout the year. We will now introduce the children to algebra, negative numbers, financial education, time, ratio, proportion, scale, 2d and 3d shape.

Lessons will involve a range of practical, written and game based learning.
