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## Literacy

**Comprehension** - We will be using a range of different texts to develop our reading for information skills.

**Listening & Talking** - This term we will be developing listening and talking skills through discussions and conversations about our whole school development tasks as well as a group presentations about the Vikings

## Maths

**Mental Maths** - We will be developing our Mental Maths skills using SAMSON and our focus for the term will be subtraction and addition mixed together.

**Core Maths Programme** -

**Numeracy** - This term we will be looking at subtraction, multiplication and the start of division.

**Space, Shape and Measure** - This term we will be looking at symmetry, data handling and measure.
