Literacy

This term we shall be looking at a non fiction book called Robert Burns in Time and Place, we will then be reading the novel Friend or Foe by Michael Morpurgo.

In writing we shall be focussing on biographies and completing tasks using the 'writing revolution'.

We shall continue to work on our comprehension skills using texts from books 'Reading from the Bookshelf' and 'Nelson'.

Maths

SAMSON - We will focus on multiplication and division this term to ensure speed and accuracy.

Octagons—This term we will work on percentages as well as negative numbers and algebra .

Miss Nicoll will focus on Data Handling and 2D shape.

Hexagons/Pentagons- This term we will continue to work on all 4 processes whilst introducing fractions and 2nd decimal place as well as . Miss Nicoll will focus on Data Handling and 2D shape.

Curricular Areas
