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Literacy

Reading—This term we will complete The Boy with the Butterfly Mind and then beginning Hag Storm. We will continue to use Book Detectives to look at further texts as groups and pupils are also encouraged to read for personal enjoyment.

Writing—This term we will focus on recount writing and informative writing. We will focus on the specific style to be used for these genres and including the techniques we have worked on in the previous terms.

Maths

Core maths

This term we are focussing on fractions, decimals, percentages, angles, directions and probability. The number processes we have looked at in previous terms will help with our understanding in these areas so please continue to practise number bonds and times tables.

Mental maths

We are continuing to focus on subtraction and introducing multiplication.

Curricular Areas

PE—This term we will focus on gymnastics (both floor and apparatus) and general fitness.

Health and Wellbeing—We will focus on healthy eating, food groups and reading food labels.

Modern Foreign Languages —In German we will translate a story from German into English. We will then begin French where we will revise greetings and introduce more conversational language.
