Everyone in Primary 5 is encouraged to read every day in order to improve their skills and will be provided with the opportunity to choose a book from the class library for personal enjoyment.

Maths

In number we are focusing on place value and addition this term, to create foundations to build on in terms 2-4. In maths we are going to concentrate on telling the time using analogue and digital clocks. This is something that everyone should practise as much as possible as it's such a valuable life skill.
