Literacy

Reading—Our class novel will be The Boy with the Butterfly Mind where we will look at writers craft and study themes such as blended families and acceptance. We will be using Book Detectives to look at further texts as groups and pupils are also encouraged to read for personal enjoyment.

Writing—This term we will focus on the fundamentals of writing high quality sentences through punctuation, sentence openers, conjunctions and vocabulary.

Curricular Areas

PE—This term we will focus on large ball skills including basketball and rugby.

Health and Wellbeing—We will focus on what makes a good friend and understanding and managing emotions.

ICT—This term we will focus on using the internet to assist with research.

German—We will begin with learning basic greetings, numbers and colours.

Maths

Core maths
