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Literacy

This term we shall be reading Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo.

Much of our writing will be linked to our WW2 topic. We will be writing newspaper reports and imaginative stories.

In talking and listening we will undertake a variety of activities to help us learn vital skills for work and life.

We shall continue to work on our comprehension skills using a range of Higher Order Thinking questions linked to passages from our topics.

In spelling we will continue to develop spelling skills and strive for neat presentation in all learning.

Maths

SAMSON -We will focus on division whilst recapping all other learnt topics from this year to ensure speed and accuracy.

Trapeziums - This term we will continue to work on time, money, algebra, ratio and proportions, angles, weight and volume.

Octagons – This term we will continue with fractions, percentages, time, money, angles, basic algebra, weight and volume.

Curricular Areas

P.E - We will be focussing on athletics to prepare for Sports' Day as well as developing ball skill games such as rugby, football, lacrosse, tennis and hockey.

Art— Many of our art activities will be based on our topics for this term.

R.M.E - We will be comparing and contrasting the religions of Islam and Christianity.

German/French - We will be revising all concepts learnt throughout primary school. There will be lots of opportunities to practise reading, writing and talking in a foreign language.

Health - This term we will be learning about drugs and substance misuse, sexual health and our growing bodies, in particular naming body parts.

Topic

This term we will continue to learn about World War 2. We will look at preparation for war and look in depth at some of the key events during the period. The children will also get opportunities to lead their learning by choosing areas of the war to do personal research on.
