We build positive partnerships with Parents and Carers to get the best for every child.

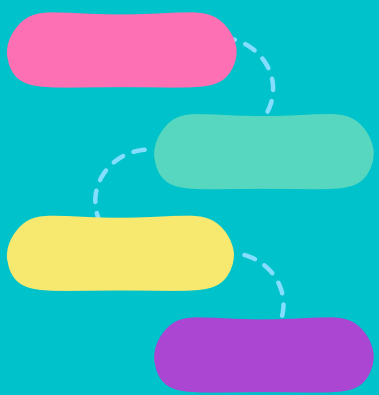
Our staff act in the best interests of their pupils and build trusting positive relationships. ✨

### RECOGNISING POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR

Our staff acknowledge when pupils make good choices and praise them for it e.g through giving House Points for good work or kind behaviour.



### RESPONDING TO INCIDENTS

Our staff have flow charts to use if problems occur. This ensures consistency across the school and has been agreed by the Parent Forum.

## BULLYING ✨

Bullying is behaviour which can make people feel hurt, threatened, frightened and left out. It can happen face to face and/or online. We create a culture of respect where bullying is recognised as unacceptable.

Our Promoting Positive Relationships procedures also cover incidents of bullying. ✨
