Interventions—Term 4

TLQ (Talking, Listening and Questioning) continue with Mrs Kennedy and run 3 times a week until completed.

Miss Schiller is delivering weekly Healthy Movers for some of our children in nursery in the gym hall this term. This is to support progress in gross motors skills, health and wellbeing and listening.

Mrs Nelson will be delivering weekly Nurture session to some children 1-1 or in small groups weekly.

Numeracy Interventions—Mrs Blackstock will continue to deliver and support numeracy interventions for small groups of children via activities or Counting Collection Packs.

Enhanced Transition_ Mrs Blackstock will support children who are part of our enhanced transition group to P1 with weekly sessions.
