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Literacy

Writing—This term we will focus on recount writing and informative writing. We will focus on the specific style to be used for these genres and including the techniques we have worked on in the previous terms.

Maths

Core maths—This term we are focussing on fractions, decimals, percentages, and time. The number processes we have looked at in previous terms will help with our understanding in these areas so please continue to practise number bonds and times tables.

Mental maths

We are continuing to focus on subtraction and introducing multiplication and division.

Curricular Areas

PE—This term we will focus on gymnastics (both floor and apparatus) and general fitness.

Health and Wellbeing—We will focus on healthy eating, food groups and reading food labels.

French —In French we will translate a story from French into English. We will then introduce more conversational language.

ICT—We will focus on learning how to type on a computer, Excel skills and coding.
