

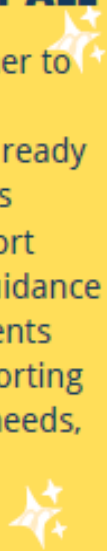


# SCHOOL UNIFORM AT NEWINGTON PRIMARY



## EXPECTATIONS OF ALL

Our school works together to ensure every child feels included, respected and ready to learn. Staff will discuss uniform with care, support families, follow safety guidance and listen to pupils. Parents and carers help by supporting their child, sharing any needs, labelling belongings and working with staff.



## CORE PRINCIPLES AND SCHOOL VALUES

### Supportive

We ensure all families can access uniform through pre-loved items and Pupil Equity Funding (Article 2 & 3)

### Honesty

We communicate clearly and openly about expectations, costs and available support (Article 12)

### Achieving

A consistent uniform helps children feel part of the school community and ready to learn (Article 28)

### Respectful

We respect individual needs, cultural identity, religious dress and personal comfort (Article 14)

### Kind

We ensure no child is judged or embarrassed for what they wear (Article 2 & 3)

## SCHOOL UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS



### TOPS

- Red Polo Shirt
- Red School Jumper or Cardigan
- Red Fleece
- Red Gingham Dress



### FOOTWEAR

Black Shoes, Boots or Trainers



### BOTTOMS

- Black or Grey Trousers/Joggers/Leggings
- Black or Grey Knee-Length Skirts or Pinafores
- Knee-Length Shorts



### JEWELLERY AND OUTERWEAR

For Health and Safety reasons, we ask that bulky earrings, chains, bracelets and rings are not worn to school



## MONITORING AND POSITIVE ENCOURAGEMENT



Our approach is nurturing and relationship-based. Staff will:

- Encourage children positively
- Communicate with families if support is needed
- Ensure no child is embarrassed or excluded due to uniform
