Our focus this term in maths is multiplication and division. It may be useful for you to practice your times tables at home, helpful links to a range of activities can also be found on Teams. Again, this is optional.



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Literacy

Reading - This term we will be reading *The Midnight Fox* by Betsy Byars.

Grammar - This term we will still be working on sentence writing, focusing on verbs, adverbs, adjectives, spoken words and homophones.

Comprehension - We will be using a range of different texts to develop our reading for information skills.

Writing - We will be looking at a range of writing styles this term including creative and imaginative.

Listening & Talking - This term we will be developing listening and talking skills through group work and through presentations.

Maths

Mental Maths - We will be developing our Mental Maths skills using SAMSON and our focus for the term will be multiplication.

Core Maths Programme - This term we will be looking at multiplication and division with numbers over 1000 using our 6,7,8 and 9 times tables.

Mrs Cannon will be focusing on Measure, Shape and Data Handling, specifically working on Area and Length, Perimeter and Scale.

Curricular Areas

PE - In PE this term our focus will be floor gymnastics and social dance.

Health & Wellbeing - This term our focus will be on Food and Health. Specifically, we will be looking closely at the link between food and exercise—the five food groups, creating a balanced meal and reading food labels.

RME - We will be looking at Judaism, and learning about the Torah and Hannukah.

This term, Primary 6 will be working with Primary 5/6, Primary 6/7 and Primary 7 on an interdisciplinary study on America. This will include looking at the History, Politics and Climate of America, whilst completing Art, Baking, Technologies and Computer based activities.
