Maths

SAMSON - We will continue with multiplication this term and recap addition and subtraction to ensure speed and accuracy.

Trapeziums - This term we will continue to work on fractions, introduce percentages, negative numbers and algebra. Miss Nicoll will focus on Data Handling and 2D shape.

Octagons - This term we will continue with decimals and introduce fractions and percentages. Miss Nicoll will focus on Data Handling and 2D shape.

Curricular Areas
