## Literacy

Reading—This term we will complete Hag Storm. We will continue to use Book Detectives to look at further texts as groups and pupils are also encouraged to read for personal enjoyment.

Writing—This term we will focus on narrative, procedure and discussion writing styles. We will focus on the specific style to be used for these genres and including the techniques we have worked on in the previous terms.

## Maths

### Core maths

This term we are focussing on money, grid references, data handling, algebra and area. The number processes we have looked at in previous terms will continue to help with understanding so please continue to practise number bonds and times tables as well as revisiting how to tell the time using analogue and digital clocks.

### Mental maths

We are continuing to focus on multiplication beyond the tables and will also introduce division.

## Curricular Areas

PE—This term we will focus on athletics, including preparations for sport's day, as well as golf.

Health and Wellbeing—We will focus on respect, substance misuse, sexual health including naming more body parts and menstruation, and advertising.

Modern Foreign Languages — This term we will focus on French, where we will look at conversation language, family members, hobbies and animals.

## Topic

This term we will finish looking at the Noble Eightfold Path in Buddhism before looking at Judaism. We will then complete a topic on the World Cup with the Primary 6 class as well as both Primary 7 classes. Pupils will be mixed between the classes and rotate amongst the teachers so they can complete each learning activity. This will encourage collaboration with pupils with whom they do not usually work.
