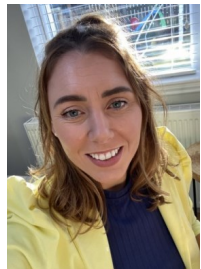

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Literacy

Maths

Mental Maths - We will be developing our Mental Maths skills using SAMSON and our focus for the term will be subtraction using the Step 1/Step 2 strategy and recapping the addition strategy by working on these both together.

Core Maths Programme - This term we will be looking at money, written multiplication as well as having a focus on the 6 and 8 times table.

Our focus for the Shape, Space and Measure area of the maths programme will be symmetry, data handling and measure.

PE - In PE this term our focus will be gymnastics and fitness and both PE lessons will be taken by Mrs Duignan

Our topic this term is **The Vikings** and things relating to how they lived and how they became a part of history.

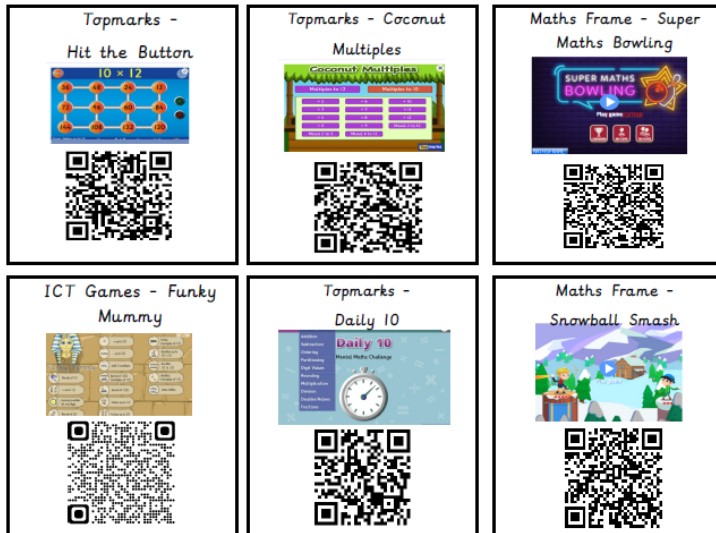

Times Table Games



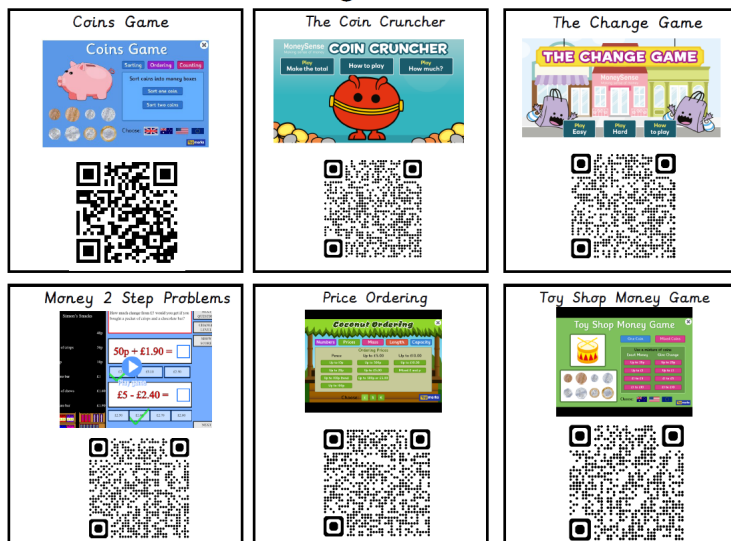
