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Literacy

Reading - This term we will be reading The Castle of Tangled Magic.

Grammar - This term we will be focusing on homophones, conjunctions, commas and speech marks.

Comprehension - We will be using a range of different texts to develop our reading for information skills.

Writing - We will be looking at writer's craft and imaginative writing using The Magic Castle as our stimulus.

Listening & Talking - This term we will be developing listening and talking skills through discussions and conversations about our whole school development tasks as well as a group presentations relating to our topic.

Maths

Mental Maths - We will be developing our Mental Maths skills using SAMSON and our focus for the term will be subtraction using the Step 1/Step 2 strategy and recapping the addition strategy by working on these both together.

Core Maths Programme - This term we will be looking at money, written multiplication as well as having a focus on the 6 and 8 times table.

Our focus for the Shape, Space and Measure area of the maths programme will be symmetry, data handling and measure.

Curricular Areas

PE - In PE this term our focus will be athletics, small balls skills and games- Mrs Duignan will be taking both PE lessons.

Health & Wellbeing - this term our focus will be focusing on where our food comes from via the idea of Farm to Fork, parenthood and relationships and gender stereotypes.

RME - We will be looking at weddings both in the Christian and Hindu faith as well as aspects of the Hindu faith.

Art - We will be looking at artwork related to The Magic Castle.

Our topic this term is **The Magic Castle** and we will be focusing on the architecture of a castle, topics related to castles such as armour and we will also through in a hint of magic!




