#### **Absence from School**

If your child is absent from school, please contact us by text on our designated absence line on <u>07860029432 text only</u>. If you are unable to make contact via text, please telephone the school office to advise.

The office staff will look to contact families directly if we have had no information about why a pupil isn't in school. The SEEMIS system will also direct us to contact parents if a pupil's absence level falls to an unacceptable level. A child's attendance at school is crucial to their progress.

#### The School Day

School activity begins at 9am and ends at 3.05pm for all pupils. We need all pupils in school on time for the start of the day. Too many regular faces appear after 9am and this has an impact on the start of the day for all pupils. Late arrivals will be recorded in SEEMIS and parents will be contacted if this becomes an issue.

Pupils will be dismissed from 3.05pm and I would ask that parents/guardians are here on time to collect their children. If you are going to be delayed, you must first try to arrange for your child to be picked up by a responsible adult and advise the school office of the change. If you are unable to make any emergency pick up arrangements, please contact the office staff ASAP and we will look at keeping your child safe in school. Please discuss with your child their end of school arrangements this will encourage independence and responsibility.

The P1 and P2 staff would also like to be informed when someone different is collecting your child so they can check this. You can either put a note in your child's school bag or advise the staff in the playground of any changes and they will relay this message to the teachers.

All pupils will continue to leave school via the usual exits, collection points for the coming session.

#### **Information Sharing with Parents**

All our pupils will work on their 'Profiles' again over the coming session, setting targets for learning and recording success and achievements over the year. Some of the teachers may send the initial information pages home to complete, we would appreciate your support with this.
