### Lit eracy

**Reading** - This term we will be reading Black Water by Barbara Henderson as it links to our Scotland topic. We will also be using the Book Detectives to look further at texts.

<u>Grammar</u> - This term we will be focusing on verbs, opposites and dictionary skills.

<u>Comprehension</u> - We will be using a range of different texts to develop our reading for information skills.

<u>Writing</u> - We will be looking at imaginative writing this term as well as using our topic for Writing Revolution activities.

<u>Listening & Talking</u> - This term we will be developing listening and talking skills through discussions and conversations about our whole school development tasks as well as a group presentations about the Vikings

### Curricular Areas

**PE** - In PE this term our focus will be athletics and Summer games.

Health & Wellbeing - this term we will continue our Roots of Empathy Programme with our tiny teacher Vinnie. We will also be focusing on the idea of farm to the fork and where our food comes from, personal health and parenthood.
