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Literacy

Reading—This term we will finish reading The Hobbit as a class, followed by Street Child by Berlie Doherty. We will be using Book Detectives to look at further texts as groups and pupils are also encouraged to read for personal enjoyment.

Writing—This term we will focus on informative writing through newspaper reports. We will learn the importance of word choice when trying to influence someone's opinion compared with writing without bias.

Curricular Areas

PE—This term we will focus on gymnastics apparatus and fitness.

Health and Wellbeing—We will focus on food including the five food groups, how to plan a healthy meal and reading food labels to check nutritional information.

<u>Languages</u>—This term we will focus on German, including parts of the body, months of the year, numbers to 31 and translating The Gruffalo from German to English.

RME—This year we will focus on Christianity and Judaism. Term Three will include Bar/Bat Mitzvahs, St David, St Patrick and Easter.

Maths

Core maths

This term we are focussing on 3D shape, symmetry, decimals, fractions, percentages and angles. We will be building upon a lot of the number work we have completed already this year as well an introducing new ideas.

Mental maths

We are focussing on mentally adding and subtracting larger numbers and decimals, and we will also begin mental multiplication. Written algorithms will focus on division.

Topic

Our topic for this term is The Victorians and we will be focussing on the life of Queen Victoria, her family tree, the life of everyday Victorians and famous people. We will be using ICT skills through projects such as creating PowerPoints and researching individuals.
