Literacy

Reading—Our class novel will be The Boy at the Back of the Class where we will look at friendships, kindness and compassion. We use our class library every day during personal reading time to enjoy books and develop our reading skills.

Writing—This term we will focus on the fundamentals of writing high quality sentences through punctuation, sentence openers, conjunctions and vocabulary.

Curricular Areas

Core maths
