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Literacy

The first class novel for the year will be Tyke Tiler. The story follows Tyke and best friend Danny through their last term at school. We will be using Blooms activities to look at further texts as groups and pupils are also encouraged to read for personal enjoyment.

Writing across term I will focus on writing accurate sentences and expanding with content linked to our topic. We will also be looking at writing persuasive pieces of text.

The class will continually be encouraged to speak clearly and fluently whilst giving input during class, group and partner discussions.

All children should aim for their best presented work at all times.

Maths

The children will revise the 4 processes of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also look at larger numbers to 1,000,000 and how to name, write and read these.

The class will also learn about how to find the area of squares, rectangles and triangles as well as learning about the properties of a variety of shapes.

Curricular Areas

RME: Our focus this year will be Christianity along with all other world religions.
