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Literacy

Reading—This term we will finish reading *The Hobbit* as a class, focussing on introducing more complex story telling and vocabulary, and then read various short stories. We will be using *Book Detectives* to look at further texts as groups and pupils are also encouraged to read for personal enjoyment.

Writing—This term we will focus on poetry and imaginative writing, where we will be improving rhythm, rhyme and writing high quality descriptions.

Maths

Core maths

This term we are focussing on time, money, measurement, data handling and algebra. We will also continue to focus on improving knowledge of number bonds and times tables.

Mental maths

We will introduce the SAMSON method of division as well as recapping the other three processes.

Curricular Areas

PE—This term we will focus on athletics and golf.

Health and Wellbeing—We will focus on creating healthy meals, substance misuse (smoking and alcohol), body changes and naming body parts, parenthood and advertising..

RME—We will complete learning about Judaism (P6) or Buddhism (P5) and continue to improve research and PowerPoint skills to demonstrate learning.

Topic

This term our main topic will be Wallace and Bruce, where we will look at Scotland in the 13th and 14th Century, influential people in that time and famous battles. We will learn through various ways, including research, art, note taking, discussions and filming our own interviews.
