support P4 throughout the week.

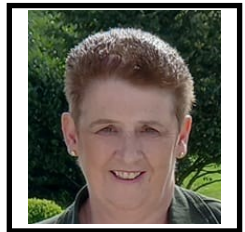
Our PE days will be **Monday** and **Thursday** - please can PE kits be brought in on these days.

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Literacy

Writing - We will be looking at tools for writing and focusing on punctuation, openers, conjunctions and vocabulary.

Listening & Talking - This term we will be developing listening and talking skills through group work and through our Christmas Concert performance.

Maths

Mental Maths - We will be developing our Mental Maths skills using SAMSON and our focus for the term will be subtraction using the Step 1/Step 2 strategy..

Core Maths Programme - This term we will be looking at written addition and subtraction as well as having a focus on the 6 times table.

Our focus for the Shape, Space and Measure area of the maths programme will be angles, journeys, compass points and grid references.

Curricular Areas

PE - In PE this term our focus will be floor gymnastics and social dance - Mrs Duignan will be taking both PE lessons.

Health & Wellbeing - this term our focus will be keeping our bodies healthy and all the things we need to do that, looking at exercise, food and the Eatwell plate.

Our topic this term is **Scotland** and we will be focusing on the geography of Scotland and famous things linked to the country.

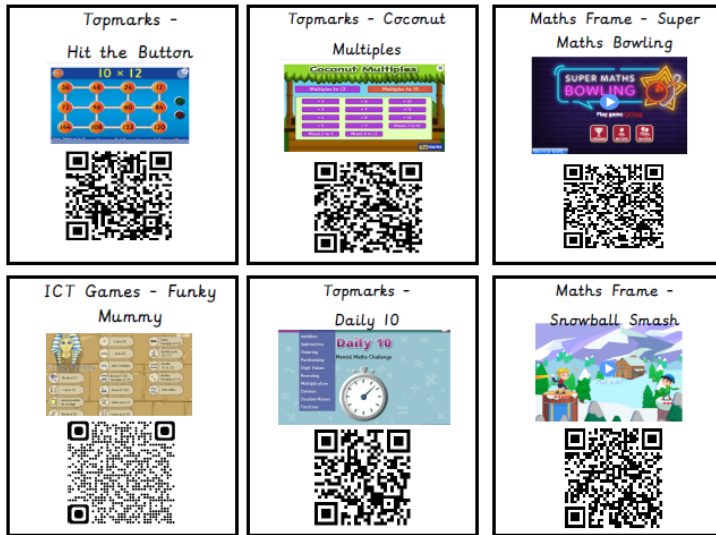




Things to Help My Learning!
