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Literacy

Reading - This term we will be reading Black Water by Barbara Henderson as it links to our Scotland topic. We will also be using the Book Detectives to look further at texts.

<u>Grammar</u> - This term we will be focusing on nouns, proper nouns and verbs.

<u>Comprehension</u> - We will be using a range of different texts to develop our reading for information skills.

<u>Writing</u> - We will be looking at functional writing this term as well as using our topic for Writing Revolution activities.

<u>Listening & Talking</u> - This term we will be developing listening and talking skills through discussions and conversations about our whole school development tasks as well as a presentation about ourselves.

<u>Mental Maths</u> - We will be developing our Mental Maths skills using SAMSON and our focus for the term will be subtraction using our strategy of counting on.
