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Literacy

Reading - This term we will be reading *Black Water* by Barbara Henderson as it links to our Scotland topic. We will also be using the *Book Detectives* to look further at texts.

Grammar - This term we will be focusing on nouns, proper nouns and verbs.

Comprehension - We will be using a range of different texts to develop our reading for information skills.

Writing - We will be looking at functional writing this term as well as using our topic for Writing Revolution activities.

Listening & Talking - This term we will be developing listening and talking skills through discussions and conversations about our whole school development tasks as well as a presentation about ourselves.

Maths

Mental Maths - We will be developing our Mental Maths skills using SAMSON and our focus for the term will be subtraction using our strategy of counting on.

Core Maths Programme -

Numeracy - This term we will be looking at addition and written addition of numbers.

Space, Shape and Measure - This term we will be looking at angles and movement.
