Literacy

Reading—We will begin our new novel Cosmic. We will continue to look at further texts in groups through Comprehension and pupils are also encouraged to read for personal enjoyment using our class library.

Writing—This term we will focus on narrative writing and exposition writing. We will focus on the specific style to be used for these genres and including the techniques we have worked on in the previous terms.

Maths

Core maths—This term we are focussing on time, money, volume, weight, algebra, and area. The number processes we have looked at in previous terms will help with our understanding in these areas so please continue to practise number bonds and times tables.

Mental maths

We are continuing to focus on multiplication, decimals and percentages.

Curricular Areas

PE—This term we will continue with fitness. Next will be athletics and will look at sprinting, hurdles, javelin, sprint relay and jumping. Then ball skills such as lacrosse and ball based games.

Health and Wellbeing—We will focus on respect, substance misuse, sexual health including naming more body parts and menstruation, and advertising.

ICT—We will continue our learning of Excel, and then move on to animations using a computer and then coding.

Topic

We will continue Victorians for the first few weeks of term. We will then start our new topic Space. We will learn through various ways, including research, art, note taking, STEM, discussions and group presentations.

We will then complete a topic on the World Cup with the Primary 6 class as well as both Primary 7 classes. Pupils will be mixed between the classes and rotate amongst the teachers so they can complete each learning activity. This will encourage collaboration with pupils with whom they do not usually work.

If your child has lost theirs please ask for it.



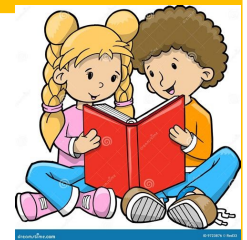
Nessy
