Primary 5/6 - Term 1



Literacy

Reading—This term we will be reading The Hobbit as a class, focussing on introducing more complex story telling and vocabulary. We will be using Book Detectives to look at further texts as groups and pupils are also encouraged to read for personal enjoyment.

<u>Writing</u>—This term we will focus on functional writing pieces and using imperative verbs.

<u>Curricular Areas</u>

<u>PE</u>—This term we will focus on large ball skills including basketball and rugby as well as improving fine and gross motor skills through bilateral.

<u>Health and Wellbeing</u>—We will focus on what makes a good friend and understanding and managing emotions.

<u>RME</u>—Throughout terms one and two pupils will be researching various aspects of Christianity and compiling their learning in a PowerPoint presentation.


Maths

<u>Core maths</u>

This term we are focussing on Place Value, Addition and Subtraction. This will set the pupils up for success with the topics we will cover later in the year.

<u>Mental maths</u>

We are focussing on mental addition through the SAMSON method this term where we will build upon what the learnt last year and introduce trickier questions.



Our topic for this term is Our European Holiday and we will be focussing on the location of Europe in the world, the European Union and countries of Europe. We will be using atlas skills as well as ICT skills through research projects.
