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Literacy

Reading—This term we will continue reading The Hobbit as a class, focussing on introducing more complex story telling and vocabulary. We will be using Book Detectives to look at further texts as groups and pupils are also encouraged to read for personal enjoyment.

<u>Writing</u>—This term we will focus on persuasive writing and using powerful language.

Curricular Areas

<u>PE</u>—This term we will focus on floor gymnastics skills and social dance.

Health and Wellbeing—We will focus on food hygiene and the importance of keeping our body healthy through exercise.

RME—Throughout terms one and two pupils will be researching various aspects of Christianity and compiling their learning in a PowerPoint presentation.

Maths

Core maths

This term we are focussing on Division, 2D shape, 3D shape and symmetry. We will also continue to focus on improving knowledge of number bonds and times tables.

Mental maths

We are now focussing on mental subtraction through the SAMSON method this term where we will build upon what the learnt last year and introduce trickier questions.

Topic

Our topic for this term is the United States of America and will be in collaboration with the P6, P6/7 and P7 classes. We will look at topics such as American history, geography, politics and weather, and pupils will take part in various practical sessions. Pupils will be in mixed class groups and will work with each class teacher for two weeks.
