Art:

In this task, you are going to focus on creating a self portait...but with a twist. This task will help you to consider how you can create light and dark, texture, line and detail.

Have a look at the two examples in Files or attached with the app. They will show you how you can create a self portrait using a collage method. You could use coloured paper or newspaper. You could even decorate your own paper!

Music:

Create a kazoo with the Royal Scottish National Orchestra (RNSO) at home!

This activity asks you to collect a few materials (hopefully you have these at home, if not, be creative!) and make a musical instrument. This will help you learn about sound and how it travels.

Wellbeing:
