## Numeracy

Today I have another problem solving task for you. Once you have finished this I have suggested some more time activities for you to practise to make sure you are confident before we move onto something else next week. ### Time Activities

- Can you create a clock outdoors with some stones, chalk, sticks etc? Have an adult tell you which time to draw and make sure you show it clearly on your clock. If it raining you could always use pasta and spaghetti indoors!
- If you have any television magazines or newspapers at home, look at the tv guide section and try to work out what time different tv shows start. Some may be tricky but you should be able to recognise those that start on the hour or at half past.
- Have a go at this game where you are given a time and have to change the hands on the clock to that time.

## Literacy



- Try to think of a toy for every letter of the alphabet. For example, a = Action Man, b = bear, c = cars... You can write these as a list or recite them onto See-Saw.
- Practise your handwriting using Doorway Online. Remember to keep your pencil on the paper whilst you are writing each letter (except when you are dotting your j and i and crossing your t and f). Focus today on making your letters neat and small. If possible, try to do this on lined paper. You can choose any letters you like today.
- Play 'Tell a TRex'. This is a reading activity where you will read a question and answer yes or no. Every correct answer feeds the TRex! For this game, Primary 1's should choose 'CCVC or CVCC' and Primary 2's can choose any sound they like. You might want to focus on a sound you have found tricky on your phonics mat!
