

PRIMARY 1A SCHOOL TRIP 2020

These are suggestions for you to have a fun day out before the end of term, as sadly we have not been able to have a school trip this year. I know that not everyone will have the time to complete all the suggested activities but hopefully you can choose something that fits in with your family and other commitments. Have fun everyone.

Option 1 - Teddy Bears Picnic

- Plan a teddy bears picnic at home or in a local park. I have posted an invitation on Seesaw that you can use to make the day special.
- Plan and make a packed lunch for the day.
- Write a shopping list.
- Go to the shop and buy what you need. Have you got enough money or are you going to pay by card?
- Fill up juice/ water bottles. – Try not to use throw away plastic.
- Make up sandwiches and cut in half or quarters.
- How many will you need for you and your family?
- Make sure that you have enough for everyone. Try some of the following teddy bear food ideas.

- Take a picnic rug with you and make sure that everyone in your family takes a teddy bear along. Design your own picnic blanket using the activity on Seesaw.



- Make your own teddies out of toilet roll tubes if you do not have enough cuddly bears. (see picture above)
- Listen to the story “We’re Going on a Bear Hunt”. Follow the link on your phones when you are out. Join in with all the actions.

Option 2 - A Day at the Seaside

Plan and make a packed lunch for the day.

- Write a shopping list.
- Go to the shop and buy what you need. Have you got enough money or are you going to pay by card?
- Make up sandwiches and cut in half or quarters.
- How many will you need for you and your family?
- Fill up juice/ water bottles. – Try not to use throw away plastic.

- What else will you need to take with you? Eg buckets, spades, sun cream, towels etc. Make a list.
- Complete the seaside scavenger hunt. (on Seesaw)
- Look in rock pools. What can you find?
- Take photographs of shells, birds, seaweed etc. Can you identify them? Use the internet to search for them when you get home.
- Use stones and shells to make some art work – create pictures, shapes and patterns. Can you do a self portrait using natural materials from the beach?
- Can you make a sea creature using natural materials from the beach?
- Listen to a story about Clark the Shark. How many rhyming words can you hear?

- Make a sand castle. Decorate it with shells, wood, stones and seaweed. Can you make a moat for your castle? Can you fill it with water?
- Visit the Life Boat Station in Anstruther. Can you see the lifeboat? Can you see the ramp that the lifeboat slides down? Look at all the different boats in the harbour there too. Walk out to see the lighthouse?
- Take pencils/crayons/pens and paper with you. Can you do a drawing of something that you see at the seaside. Try to add as much detail as possible.
- Sing along to the song “When I was one, I had some fun the day I went to sea.”
